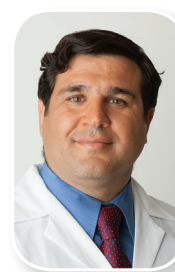
Vascular Disease is a serious disease of the arteries and veins that blocks circulation anywhere in the body. It can lead to disability, amputation, organ damage and even death.

Peripheral Artery Disease (PAD) is a narrowing of the peripheral arteries, most commonly in the arteries of the pelvis and legs. Like coronary artery disease and carotid artery disease, it is caused by narrowed and blocked arteries in various critical regions of the body. The most common symptoms of PAD are cramping, pain or tiredness in the leg or hip muscles while walking or climbing stairs. Typically, this pain goes away with rest and returns when you walk again. Unfortunately, PAD often goes undiagnosed by healthcare professionals. If left untreated, PAD can lead to gangrene and amputation.

A blockage in one or more arteries in the lungs, a Pulmonary Embolism is caused by blood clots that travel to the lungs from another part of the body. It is a complication of Deep Vein Thrombosis (DVT), which is clotting in the veins, usually in the legs.

Half of all DVT cases are asymptomatic. Symptoms include pain or tenderness in one or both legs, warmth in the skin and/or red or discolored skin in the affected leg, visible surface veins and leg fatigue. An estimated 60,000 deaths are caused annually by this condition.

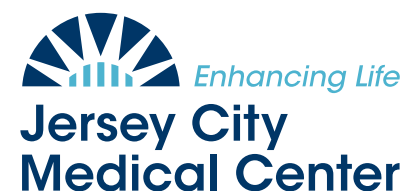
