MASSH is committed to meeting the needs of low income, working poor, uninsured, underinsured and homeless adults throughout Hudson County. We provide outreach throughout the community to reach the homeless population who are often hard to engage and reluctant to seek services. Services include: physical examinations, immunizations, referrals for specialized medical services, referrals for medication vouchers, Tuberculosis, Diabetic, and Hypertension screenings, HIV/AIDS healthcare, advocacy, education, and case management, case management and Psychiatric Evaluations for homeless adults who are mentally ill (PATH), substance abuse assessments and referrals, and transportation to and from local homeless shelters for appointments.

We provide linkages to the following:
