**Trauma Attending:** Ottley

**Case Description/Narrative:** 44M, MCC, with helmet. Found unresponsive and pulseless. Bystander CPR initiated. ALS on scene and patient noted to be in PEA. ACLS initiated, pt intubated, epinephrine administered. 15 min downtime prior to arrival and patient remained in PEA. In TB, pt was pulseless, pupils F&D, large L hemotympanum. FAST performed, revealed no cardiac activity. Pt without SOL for >15 mins. Pronounced.

**Evaluation/Analysis/Opinion:** Appropriate care. Non-preventable death.
