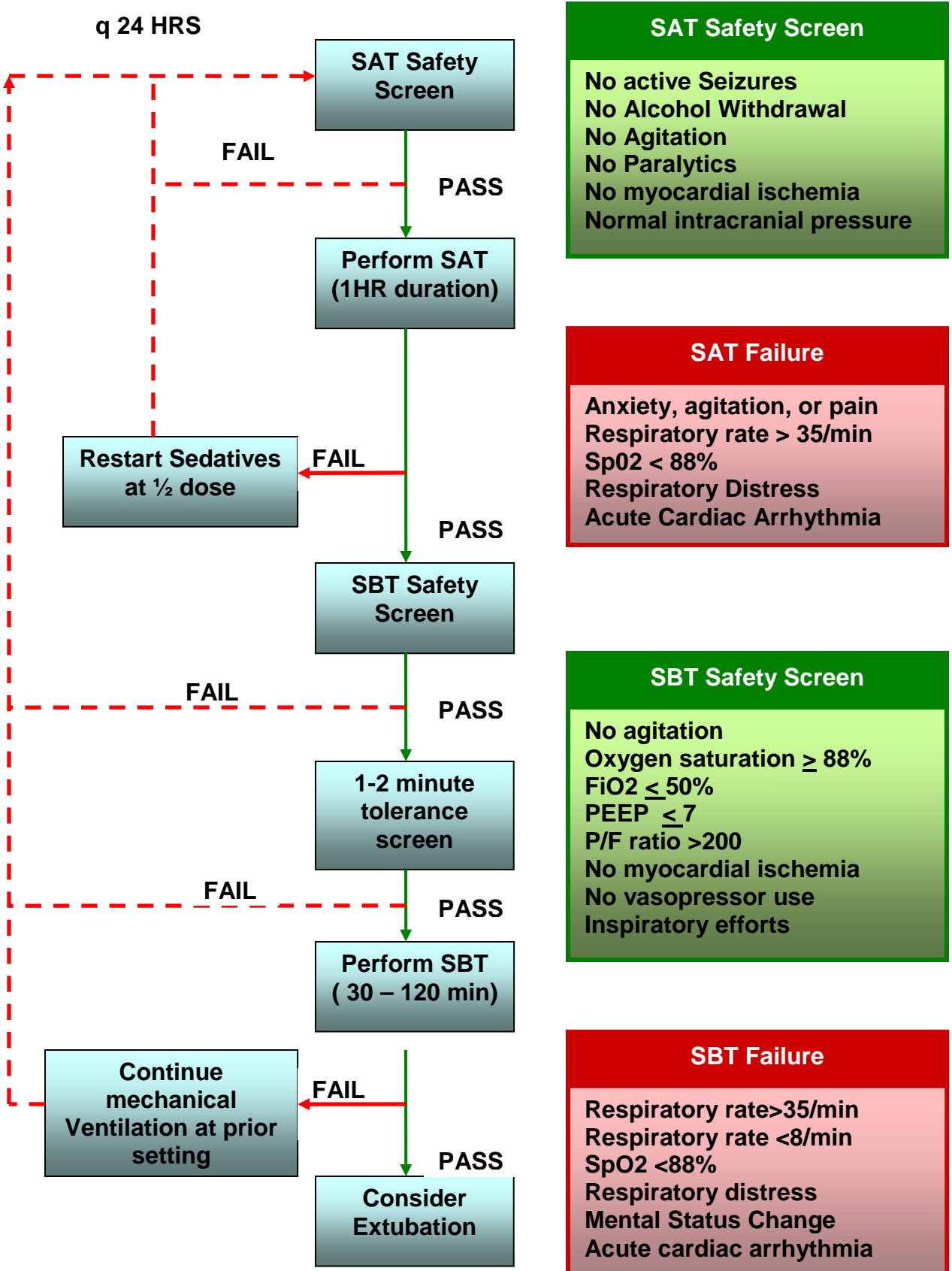

Spontaneous Awakening Trials (SATs) + Spontaneous Breathing Trials (SBTs)



SAT Safety Screen

- No active Seizures
- No Alcohol Withdrawal
- No Agitation
- No Paralytics
- No myocardial ischemia
- Normal intracranial pressure

SAT Failure

- Anxiety, agitation, or pain
- Respiratory rate > 35/min
- SpO2 < 88%
- Respiratory Distress
- Acute Cardiac Arrhythmia

SBT Safety Screen

- No agitation
- Oxygen saturation ≥ 88%
- FiO2 ≤ 50%
- PEEP ≤ 7
- P/F ratio >200
- No myocardial ischemia
- No vasopressor use
- Inspiratory efforts

SBT Failure

- Respiratory rate >35/min
- Respiratory rate <8/min
- SpO2 <88%
- Respiratory distress
- Mental Status Change
- Acute cardiac arrhythmia

Order is needed for extubation
