One will be kept in the permanent record and the other is given to the patient. The process will be standardized for critical care and med/surg: assessment of vaccine criteria will be done upon admission and vaccines will be administered as soon as it is determined that the patient meets criteria.	Claudia will send email regarding the following: Both critical care and med/surg will document in their handoff (both are part of Medical record) the vaccine assessment was done and vaccine status, if patient currently does not meet criteria. Questions: The nurses wanted to know if it is still expected to assess all patients for vaccine criteria regardless of age and if so where do they document there assessment. For example a 20 year that does not meet any inclusion or exclusion criteria. Are they required to assess and offer the vaccines to them?
